

How to have a socially distant, in-person, golf tournament.

- Set up an online registration
- You're going to need more golf carts, and may have to rent extra.
- Need to find a way to rework the meal. Could consider having individual boxed lunches and individual coolers
- May have to do multiple days. Maybe morning tee times for three consecutive Mondays.
- Make an awesome goodie bag that provides everything your participants need throughout the day and gives the touches your sponsors need to happen.
- Have sponsors every three holes to make connections.

How to have a virtual golf tournament

- Have your participants put together a four-person scramble team per usual.
- Rather than setting their tee time, consider selling each team a voucher that is good for a week and includes two weekends (be sure it's the same golf course).
 - Have your participants turn their scorecard into the pro-shop.
 - You can provide the same all-inclusive goodie bag for them.
- This is an opportunity make more money. If you can have the guts to ask, your expenses are down. Some organizations have made more money by cancelling their events this year so don't psych yourself out.
 - If it's going to cost you a lot, maybe not having a golf tournament is the right move.
 - Maybe you could have a golf video game tournament.

How to keep the camaraderie and social aspect high

- Group teams that like to golf together if possible.
- Have a social board of photos that is added to in real time.
